on her mind for some time past to attend the approaching Yearly Meeting to be held in Philadelphia which concern being after being seriously considered was fully united with and she left at liberty to pursue her prospect according to the openings of Divine Truth in her own mind. The clerk is directed to unite with the clerk of the men's meeting in signing a minute expressive hereof.
