Answers to the Queries.

1st ans, All our meetings for worship and discipline have been held and generally well attended - No unbecoming behaviour to remark - The hour observed

by most friends.

2nd ans, We believe friends maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession - Talebearing and detraction discouraged - We know of no differences amongst us,

3rd ans, We believe friends endeavour by example and precept to bring up their children, and those under their care, in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and to some extent in the plainness of speech, deportment, and apparel, which the Gospel enjoins. We believe they are guarded from reading pernicious books and from the corrupt conversation of the world - and they are encouraged frequently to read the Holy Scriptures. There is more deficiency apparent with regard to plainness of speech, deportment, and apparel, than the ^{other} points queried after, but we feel that a more earnest religious concern would be desirable in all the important subjects alluded to.

4th ans, We believe most friends faithfully maintain our testimony to a free Gospel ministry, agreeably to our discipline.

5th ans, We believe friends are mostly careful as regards the several requisitions of this query.

6th, The necessities of the poor are inspected and relieved; They are advised and assisted in such employment as they are capable of. No children to educate.

7th ans, Clear as regards the forepart of this Query - Those of the African race under their care are suitably provided
