2nd ans, We believe friends maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession - False bearing and detraction are discouraged - We know of no differences amongst us,

3rd ans, We believe friends endeavour by example and precept, to bring up their children and those under their care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord - and to some extent in the plainness of speech, deportment, and apparel which the Gospel enjoins - Some care is taken to guard them against reading pernicious books, and from the corrupt conversation of the world - And they are encouraged to read the Holy Scriptures. But we feel that there is need for a more earnest Christian care in all these important particulars.

4th ans, We believe most friends maintain our testimony to a free Gospel ministry, agreeably to our Discipline

5th ans, We believe friends are clear with regard to the several particulars of this query.

6th ans, The necessities of the poor and the circumstances of those requiring aid are inspected and relieved. They are advised and assisted in such employments as they are capable of when necessary; Due care is taken to provide for the education of Friends children.

7th ans, We believe friends are clear with regard to

the several particulars queried after.

8th ans, Friends are careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage, or engaging in hazardous or speculative trade - They are clear of defrauding the public revenue - They are just in their dealings, and punctual in complying with their engagements.

9th ans, Care is taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and to evince to those who will not be reclaimed the spirit of meekness and love before judgment is placed upon them.

Tenth ans, none.

Eleventh ans, none.

Twelfth ans, Most friends are careful as far as practicable, to place their children for tuition under the charge of suitable teachers in membership with us.
