

At Baltimore Monthly Meeting of
Women Friends for the Eastern &
Western Districts - held 3/8th 1844

The committee named to

Friends to serve as clerk & assistant-
clerk informed the meeting that
they had conferred together & were
united in proposing the name
of Margaret H. Elliott for clerk &
M. Alice Brooks for assistant-
clerk with which this meeting
united, & they were accordingly
appointed for the ensuing year.

certificate of removal had been
received & read in this meeting.

This meeting made the
following proposition to men's
meeting which was acceded to by them.

ting the business of both meetings

shall be acted upon before taking
up business which comes only before
the separate meeting.

informed this meeting that he
felt the time had come for him
to complete the service of paying
religious visits to families to which
he felt called last spring, & which
circumstances prevent him from
completing. This meeting fully
united with his concern & the
desire was expressed that his
service might be blessed to all
those whom he visited.
