

At Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends, Women, for the Eastern and Western Districts, held 8th. mo. 8th. 1889.

The clerk being absent, Anna King Carey, was appointed for the day.

The committee appointed to bring forward the names of Friends to serve as overseers, proposed the names of Jane P. Winslow, Mary B. Nicholson, Elizabeth R. Hopkins, and Margaret A. Elliott; which were acceptable to the meeting, and they were accordingly appointed to that station.

The application for membership with Friends of William Howard Martineau was received from new Friends, with the information that they were united in granting the same, which was concurred in by this meeting. A communication was received from Washington meeting, saying, they were going to lay down the meeting during the 7th, 8th, and 9th mos.

This meeting was informed by the Quarterly Meeting of Ministry and Oversight, that they were united in

the judgment of Baltimore Monthly Meeting, in believing that a gift in the ministry had been committed to John L. Thomas, and this meeting directs that he be recorded as a minister of the Society of Friends.

A communication from Merrett Haveiland and his wife Lydia W. asking that their memberships, and that of their three children, Meriam W. Daniel P. and Ebenezer W. Haveiland, should be removed to Ashton Monthly Meeting, they having settled within the limits of that meeting, was read, and Mary B. Nicholson and Clarissa F. Davis were appointed, with a similar committee of new Friends, to make the usual enquiries thereto, and, if way should open, to produce a form of certificate of removal for the above named Friends.
