We have examined the Treasurer's accounts for year ending 11th mo. 30th 1890, and find them correct, with the necessary vouchers. The amount collected during the year was \$2423.- and the amount expended was \$1919.²⁹, leaving a balance in the hands of the Treasurer of \$516.⁸⁸. In view of the probability of a considerable amount being soon needed for repairs and for City assessments, we recommend that the sum of \$2500.- be raised for the coming year.
