The following report of Friends' Association for Christian Work was read, and with two corrections accepted. Owing to no written report having been handed in, there was no mention of Y. A. F. W. Children's Union or Mother's Meeting.

Friends Association for Christian Work, makes the following report of the different branches of Bible School, Home Mission and Temperance work under its care.

The Bible School, at our Meeting House, East and Street, shows an increase in average attendance of 5, over the corresponding Quarter of last year: the contributions of the School show some decrease however. There are 46 children on the roll: the average attendance for last three months of 1890 was 59 for the whole School, including Bible classes. The Boys Meeting at Federal Hill has been held as usual, with about the same attendance as last year, and evidences of the good results of the School are continually coming
